BUILDING KINBROOK

Construction works are progressing well across the Kinbrook estate.

The English Street and Norman Road intersection is now well underway and the road is really starting to take shape. The stormwater drains are completed and the construction of the road pavement has begun. Water main construction is also well advanced and this will be followed by kerb and channel works.

Works are also underway and progressing well in Stages 17 and 18. Stage 17 is at a similar stage to the English Street and Norman Road intersection with road pavements being constructed. Stage 18 construction is currently focused on the installation of the stage's sewerage and stormwater drainage systems, followed by water supply.
